

Acceptable Use Policy

Last updated: May 26, 2026

This Acceptable Use Policy (“Policy”) explains what is and is not allowed when using Trafium, available at <https://trafium.ai>.

Trafium is operated by TRAFIUM LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY, a company registered in the Republic of Armenia (“Trafium”, “TRAFIUM LLC”, “we”, “us”, or “our”).

This Policy forms part of our Terms of Service. By using Trafium, creating an account, adding funds, generating websites, generating articles, using WordPress-related tools or plugins, connecting integrations, or using any automation feature, you agree to this Policy.

1. Purpose of This Policy

Trafium provides AI-powered website generation, article generation, SEO content automation, semantic keyword collection, WordPress-related publishing tools, and related digital services.

You may use Trafium only for lawful, legitimate, and authorized purposes.

You must not use Trafium to create, publish, distribute, automate, support, or promote illegal, harmful, deceptive, abusive, or unauthorized content or activity.

2. General Responsibility

You are responsible for everything you create, generate, publish, export, automate, or distribute using Trafium.

You must review AI-generated content before publishing it.

You must ensure that your use of Trafium complies with:

- applicable laws;
- third-party rights;
- platform rules;
- search engine guidelines;
- hosting provider rules;
- payment provider rules;
- AI provider policies;
- WordPress, CMS, plugin, and integration rules;
- our Terms of Service;
- this Policy and other Trafium policies.

3. Prohibited Content and Activities

You must not use Trafium to create, generate, host, publish, export, automate, or distribute any content or activity listed below.

3.1 Spam and Deceptive SEO

You must not use Trafium for:

- spam websites;
- mass unsolicited content;
- automated spam campaigns;
- doorway pages;
- thin affiliate spam;
- cloaking;
- keyword stuffing;
- deceptive SEO schemes;
- automated low-quality content networks;
- content designed mainly to manipulate search rankings;
- large-scale search engine abuse;
- fake traffic schemes;
- link farms;
- private blog network abuse;
- scraped content republishing without rights.

Trafium is intended for legitimate website and content creation, not for spam or search engine manipulation.

3.2 Phishing, Impersonation, and Fraud

You must not use Trafium to create or support:

- phishing pages;
- fake login pages;
- credential theft;
- brand impersonation;
- government impersonation;
- bank or payment provider impersonation;
- fake customer support websites;
- fake crypto or wallet websites;
- investment scams;
- giveaway scams;
- romance scams;
- job scams;
- fake invoices;
- fraudulent commercial offers;
- deceptive checkout pages;
- misleading business identities.

You must not represent yourself as another person, company, brand, institution, or government entity without authorization.

3.3 Malware and Security Abuse

You must not use Trafium to create, host, publish, distribute, or support:

- malware;
- spyware;
- ransomware;
- trojans;
- botnets;
- viruses;
- credential stealers;
- keyloggers;
- malicious scripts;
- exploit kits;
- unauthorized vulnerability exploitation;
- denial-of-service activity;
- hacking tools intended for abuse;
- content that instructs users to install harmful software.

You must not use Trafium to attack, scan, overload, compromise, or disrupt any system, website, API, server, network, or account.

3.4 Copyright, Trademark, and Intellectual Property Infringement

You must not use Trafium to infringe intellectual property rights, including:

- copyright infringement;
- trademark infringement;
- unauthorized use of brand names;
- unauthorized use of logos;
- copying third-party websites without permission;
- publishing stolen content;
- using protected images, text, code, video, audio, or media without rights;
- creating websites that imitate competitors or third-party brands in a misleading way.

You are responsible for ensuring that you have the rights to all materials you submit, generate, use, publish, or distribute.

3.5 Illegal or Regulated Goods and Services

You must not use Trafium to promote, sell, support, or facilitate illegal goods or services.

You must not use Trafium for unauthorized or unlawful promotion of:

- illegal drugs;

controlled substances;
weapons;
explosives;
counterfeit goods;
stolen goods;
human trafficking;
sexual exploitation;
illegal gambling;
illegal financial services;
unlicensed investment products;
unlicensed medical products;
fake documents;
illegal hacking services;
other prohibited or regulated goods or services.

If your business is regulated, you are responsible for obtaining and maintaining all required licenses, approvals, disclosures, and compliance controls.

3.6 Misleading Professional Advice

You must not use Trafium to publish misleading, unsafe, or unqualified professional advice, including:

medical advice;
legal advice;
financial advice;
investment advice;
tax advice;
insurance advice;
safety-critical instructions;
emergency guidance.

AI-generated content must not be presented as professional advice unless properly reviewed and approved by a qualified professional.

3.7 Hate, Harassment, and Abuse

You must not use Trafium to create or publish content that promotes:

hate;
violence;
harassment;
threats;
targeted abuse;
doxxing;
stalking;
extremism;
terrorist activity;

incitement to violence;
dehumanization of protected groups.

3.8 Adult and Sexual Exploitation Content

You must not use Trafium to create, host, publish, distribute, or promote:

illegal sexual content;
sexual exploitation;
non-consensual intimate content;
sexual content involving minors;
content that facilitates trafficking or exploitation;
adult services where prohibited by law or payment provider rules.

3.9 Fake Reviews and Deceptive Claims

You must not use Trafium to create or publish:

fake reviews;
fake testimonials;
fake endorsements;
fake case studies;
false customer claims;
misleading product comparisons;
deceptive earnings claims;
false guarantees;
fabricated statistics;
false scarcity claims;
fake authority signals.

You must not use AI-generated content to mislead users, customers, search engines, platforms, or regulators.

3.10 Privacy Violations and Data Abuse

You must not use Trafium to:

collect personal data unlawfully;
scrape personal data without rights;
publish private personal information;
doxx individuals;
generate content using personal data without lawful basis;
send unsolicited messages;
violate privacy laws;
track users unlawfully;
process sensitive personal data without permission and legal basis.

You are responsible for ensuring that any personal data you submit to Trafium is collected and used lawfully.

3.11 Sanctions, AML, and Restricted Use

You must not use Trafium if doing so would violate applicable sanctions, export controls, AML rules, payment restrictions, or other legal restrictions.

You must not use Trafium for the benefit of sanctioned persons, restricted parties, prohibited entities, or restricted jurisdictions.

Trafium may refuse service, reject payments, block access, suspend accounts, or request additional information if we detect legal, sanctions, fraud, AML, payment, or compliance risk.

4. WordPress, CMS, and Integration Rules

If you connect WordPress, CMS, hosting, domain, API, or other integrations, you represent that you own or are authorized to manage them.

You must not connect:

- hacked websites;
- unauthorized CMS accounts;
- third-party websites without permission;
- compromised hosting accounts;
- stolen API keys;
- unauthorized domains;
- accounts obtained through fraud or abuse.

You are responsible for maintaining security, backups, updates, plugins, themes, credentials, permissions, and access controls for your connected websites and integrations.

5. Autoposting Rules

If you enable autoposting, scheduled publishing, or publishing automation, you are responsible for all published content.

You must not use autoposting to:

- publish spam;
- flood websites with low-quality content;
- publish illegal content;
- publish content without review where review is legally or practically required;
- impersonate brands or people;
- publish content to websites you do not own or control;
- bypass platform rules;
- publish malware, phishing, or deceptive pages;
- create mass doorway networks.

Trafium may suspend or disable autoposting features if we detect abuse, suspicious activity, complaints, policy violations, or technical risk.

6. AI-Generated Content Rules

AI-generated content may be inaccurate, incomplete, outdated, similar to existing content, or unsuitable for your intended use.

You must review AI-generated content before publishing, selling, relying on, or distributing it.

You must not present AI-generated content as human-reviewed, expert-reviewed, legally approved, medically verified, financially reliable, or guaranteed unless that is true and properly documented.

You are responsible for checking:

- factual accuracy;
- legal compliance;
- copyright compliance;
- trademark compliance;
- brand safety;
- SEO suitability;
- third-party rights;
- professional advice requirements;
- platform policy compliance.

7. Payment Abuse

You must not engage in:

- payment fraud;
- stolen payment methods;
- crypto payment abuse;
- refund abuse;
- duplicate account abuse;
- attempted balance manipulation;
- chargeback abuse;
- false refund claims;
- money laundering;
- use of Trafium balance for purposes outside the platform.

Trafium account balance may only be used to purchase digital services on trafium.ai.

8. Abuse Reporting

If you believe Trafium is being used for abuse, illegal activity, infringement, phishing, malware, spam, or other harmful activity, contact us at:

Please include:

the relevant URL or account information, if available;
description of the issue;
evidence or screenshots, if available;
your contact information;
any supporting legal or technical details.

9. Enforcement

Trafium may investigate suspected violations of this Policy.

We may take any action we consider appropriate, including:

warning the user;
removing or disabling content;
disabling autoposting;
disconnecting integrations;
limiting generation features;
blocking exports;
restricting account access;
suspending or terminating the account;
refusing payments;
withholding or cancelling balance credits where permitted;
reporting illegal activity to authorities or affected third parties;
preserving evidence for legal or security purposes.

We are not required to provide prior notice before taking action if we believe there is legal, security, payment, fraud, abuse, or platform risk.

10. No Refund for Violations

If your account is suspended or terminated for violating this Policy, you may lose access to Trafium.

You are not entitled to a refund for used balance, generated content, generated websites, generated articles, automation tasks, exports, or other digital services provided before or during enforcement action.

Unused balance may be reviewed according to our Refund Policy, payment provider rules, compliance requirements, and applicable law.

11. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Acceptable Use Policy from time to time.

If we make material changes, we may provide notice through Trafium, by email, or by posting a notice on trafium.ai.

Your continued use of Trafium after the updated Policy becomes effective means you accept the updated Policy.
